The program consists of three required parts:

Part 1: March-April 2023 (fully on-line, self-paced instruction and synchronous meetings)

Part 2: July 18-25, 2023 (in-person, residential teacher camp, College of the Holy Cross, Worcester, Massachusetts. (Travel, room, and board provided by the program.)

Part 3: December 2023-February 2024 (fully on-line, synchronous, and asynchronous)

Eligibility:

- 2 years of full-time CFL teaching experience at the middle school, high school, or college level in the US
- US citizenship or legal resident status
- CFL teaching position in the US for the 2023-2024 academic year
