Step 3: Explore routes to certification

Types of certification

- GA Teacher Ed → Pre-Service certificate → Initial Certification
- Provisional Certification (teaching position prep program/3-year, non-renewable certificate)
- <u>Induction Certificate</u> (in-state/out-of-state programs) Pressional
 Certificate
- <u>Permits</u> (foreign language field- bachelor degree or higher, employment)
- Career, Technical, and Agricultural Education (CTAE) Certification
- Paraprofessional Licensure
