2018 GEORGIA CHINESE LANGUAGE EDUCATORS (GCLE) ONLINE TALENT CONTEST

Rules & Prizes

Eligibility:

Any middle-school student (non-native and non-heritage speaker of Chinese) enrolled in a Chinese program in Georgia and whose teacher is a current GCLE member.

Content:

A two-minute Chinese talent act, which can be any form of performance as long as it is related to Chinese language or culture, e.g., playing Chinese instruments, singing songs, doing Chinese dance, martial arts, acrobatics, traditional Chinese opera, traditional Chinese sports, paper-cutting, cross talk, Chinese painting, calligraphy, etc. It can be an individual act or a group act.

Participation:

To enter the contest, register with your teacher, have your parents sign the media release form, turn in the form to your teacher; practice and record your

act, save the video file on a USB drive and give it to your teacher.

Timeline:

Register with your teacher by March 9th; turn your video file in to your teacher by April 8th. Winners will be announced by April 29th, 2018.

Evaluation Criteria:

Showcase students' understanding of Chinese language or culture. Originality in production. Skillfulness in execution.

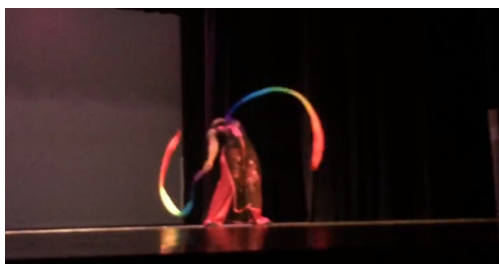
Prizes:
