Rules

How to participate:

1. Register all participating students individually online by clicking on the attached link and completing the registration before **Friday, March 9, 2018.**
2. After submitting the registration form, help students practice and record their talent act. Then email the following materials by **Sunday, April 8th** to gclgroup@gmail.com:
 - Participant Name(s) and grade(s)
 - Video file or a video link (maximum two minutes) of the participant's talent act.
 - Attachment of the signed and scanned copy of the media release form from each of the participant's parent.
 - Make sure the **email subject** includes the following information:
School name + Teacher name + MS talent contest 2018

Who is eligible?

1. Any middle-school student (only non-native and non-heritage speakers of Chinese) enrolled in school with a Chinese language program in the state of Georgia.
2. Each school is asked to limit their recommendations to 3 talent acts.

What is a talent act?

A two-minute Chinese talent act can demonstrate any form of performance as long as it is related to Chinese language or culture, e.g., playing Chinese instruments, singing Chinese songs, traditional Chinese opera, doing Chinese dance, martial arts, acrobatics, traditional Chinese sports, Chinese paper-cut, cross talk, Chinese painting, calligraphy, etc. It can be an individual act or a group act. Students should be speaking and using Chinese in their talent act.

Prizes:

1. Final results will be announced on Monday, April 30th
2. Certificates will be awarded to one first-place, two second-place and three third- place winners. Each winning entry, regardless of the number of participants, is limited to one certificate.
3. Winning entries will be featured on the GCLE website.
