Rules & Prizes

Eligibility:

Any middle school and high school students enrolled in a Chinese program in Georgia and whose teacher is a current GCLE member.

Content:

A three-minute video performance of a Chinese song. It can be a solo or duet. Start with a brief self-introduction in Chinese.

Participation:

To enter the contest, register with your teacher; have your parents sign the Media Release Form; practice and record your song, upload your video; submit the link and the signed Media Release Form online; be prepared to perform in front of a live audience.

Timeline:

Register with your teacher by Feb. 22nd; submit your link online by Mar. 15th. Selected students will be invited to a live contest on Apr. 13th. Location will be announced at a later date.

Evaluation Criteria:

Showcase students' understanding of Chinese language and culture, originality in production, skillfulness in execution.

Prizes:

Certificates and prizes will be awarded to one first-place, two second-place and three third- place winners. All candidates will be recognized for participation.
